Posted 05/06/2024: webTrans Upgrade 05/07/24

OATI will be deploying a change to BPAT Production webTrans starting at 2:45pm PPT on Tuesday May 7, 2024. The system will be unavailable for up to 60 minutes starting at this time. The impact will be as follows:

1. CDE users will not be able to login until the system upgrade has been completed. Users that are already logged in at the time the upgrade starts will not be automatically logged out of the system, but screens may not be fully functional until the upgrade is complete.
2. webSmartOASIS and webSmartTag will both still be available. However, TSRs will not be processed until webTrans is back online, so plan accordingly. Tag processing should not be affected.
3. XML queries against webTrans will be unavailable during this time.
4. Other system notifications such as JOTS emails and EIDE communications will also be unavailable.

At least 30 minutes prior to the actual implementation, a message will be sent confirming the start time. A second message will be sent when the system becomes available again.

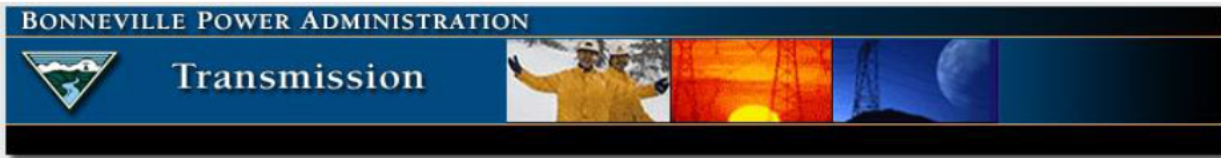

Posted 04/17/2024: EIM Dispute for CIDI # 00273825 - DENIED - BPA and CAISO discrepancy causing a reduced credit to CC 64750 on 3/18/24

The CAISO completed research and confirmed their calculations are accurate. However, the CAISO was willing to meet with BPA to go over variances. BPA reviewed data and discovered the cause for the variances on 3/18/2024, HE 8-12. The variance resulted in an amount of \$mw and \$213.66, affecting Charge Code 64750. BPA requested the ticket be closed.

| 2/27/2024 | 1/24/2024 | 272318 | BPA Submitted T-40 Base Schedule, but CAISO used the T-55 causing a reduced credit to CC 64750 on 1/24/24. | BPA experienced a balancing test imbalance of 73mw. BPA noticed the imbalance was due to the CAISO using the T-55 BS results. BPA had submitted a T-40 BS, which was not reflected in CMRI. BPA is requesting the T-40 BS value be used for Settlements. Dispute amount: \$3,408.40. | Per CAISO on 3/6/24: Approved. CAISO approved BPA's request for the use of our T-40 BS value instead of the T-55 CAISO used for the Initial 9 settlement statement. The variance had caused an imbalance of 73mw. The dispute is Pending Recalculation on the T+70B settlement Statement, which will post 5/2/24. Dispute amount: \$3,408.40. |
