

Joint Owned Transmission System Automated Capacity Change Notification

To receive the automated notification of TTC changes, an Intertie Capacity Owner must complete all sections of this form and submit it to Bonneville Power Administration Transmission Services (BPAT) by email to txcbs@bpa.gov. Only typed forms will be accepted. Handwritten information will not be accepted.

Upon receipt of a properly completed form, BPAT shall have 30 days to complete the setup or make changes. BPAT will email the Capacity Owner confirmation of the information that was received and notify them when the setup is completed. The Intertie Capacity Owner is responsible for the timely notification of changes to this information.

For EIDE communication, the Capacity Owner must have a secure server ready to receive EIDE message packets at the specified URL. BPAT will provide the EIDE setup information to the Capacity Owner's Representative listed in Section 6.
