# Did you know? Energy efficiency federal tax credits are now available for your customers

On Aug. 16, 2023, Congress approved the most significant piece of clean energy legislation in the Nation's history. The Inflation Reduction Act, or IRA, will invest \$370 Billion to lower energy costs for families and small businesses while also creating good paying jobs to deliver energy investments. While many rules and guidelines for the IRA are still being developed by the Department of Energy along with state energy offices, households can already take advantage of Federal Home Energy Tax Credits. These are separate from BPA incentives but because they are available at the same time, there is even greater savings for your customers....More
