Washer/dryer combo guidance

Several utilities have inquired about new washer/dryer combination units coming out in the appliance market. Until a Regional Technical Forum (RTF) measure has been developed, BPA has determined that utilities may claim both washer and dryer incentive payments. Units must be listed on the <u>ENERGY STAR combination units qualified product list</u> to receive the ENERGY STAR payments. Units must additionally be on the <u>BPA Clothes Dryer qualified product list</u> to receive higher-tiered dryer payments. This applies to both standard and low income measures. The total low income measure costs cannot exceed the final cost of the installation. Please refer to the ENERGY STAR website and the BPA Clothes Dryer Qualified Product List for more details.
