#### Background

- North American Electric Reliability Corporation (NERC) is retiring the ATC MODs on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024
  - a. BPA uses NERC MOD-001, MOD-029 and MOD-008, and references these standards in many of its ATC methodology documents
  - ATC requirements have moved to North American Energy Standards
     Board Wholesale Electric Quadrant business practice standard 023
     (WEQ-023)
- 2. Given the upcoming retirement of the NERC ATC standards, BPA will need to update its ATC Methodology documentation to remove references to these standards

### Background (cont.)

- 3. This retirement also creates an opportunity for streamlining of BPA's ATCID and TRMID
  - Many requirements found in the NERC ATC MODs were not transferred to WEQ-023, and will thus be permanently retired
  - BPA would like to remove language relating to these requirements from its documentation, if the language is not pertinent to BPA's ATC methodology
- 4. Today, BPA will review the proposed changes to the ATCID and TRMID due to this retirement
- 5. There are no changes to BPA's methodology; the goal of this effort is to simplify documentation

#### Documentation Updates – ATCID

- BPA has removed all references to the NERC ATC MODs throughout the document
- 2. Language on how BPA establishes Total Transfer Capability (TTC) has been aligned with WEQ-023
- Definitions for various acronyms (i.e. ATC, TTC) have also been aligned with the current definitions found in WEQ-023

#### Documentation Updates – ATCID (cont.)

- BPA has deleted language related to requirements that are being permanently retired, if the language is not pertinent to BPA's ATC methodology
  - a. Language on limiting assumptions (related to MOD-001, R6 & R7)
  - b. List of Transmission Operators (TOs) contiguous to BPA's TO area (related to MOD-029, R1)
  - List of TOs and TSPs that BPA receives data from and provides data to, for purposes of TTC/ATC calculations (related to MOD-001, R3.3 & 3.4)
  - d. Language on how to request TTC study reports from BPA (related to MOD-029, R4)
  - e. Miscellaneous language relating to what BPA does not do, or will do in the future (various MOD requirements)

#### Documentation Updates – ATCID (cont.)

- BPA has updated language on data sharing and information requests, to align with the data sharing requirements in WEQ-023
  - a. Language reflects new timeline for responding to written methodology clarifications and data requests (45 calendar days)
- 6. BPA has updated language on how the ATCID is made available, to align with updated WEQ-023 requirements

#### Documentation Updates – TRMID

- BPA removed references to the NERC ATC MODs
- BPA re-organized the information in the document to make it more user-friendly
  - a. Components of Uncertainty information has been incorporated into the sections that describe the TRM methodology for each path
- BPA has updated the language in the TRMID Requests section to align with the requirements in WEQ-023
  - a. Language reflects new timeline for responding to written methodology clarifications (45 calendar days)

#### ATC Methodology Website Changes

- 1. The NERC Horizon (0-13 months) will be renamed to Short-term Horizon (0-13 months)
  - a. BPA will make this change on its ATC Methodology page on February 1<sup>st</sup>, 2024, and will continue to update references to this horizon in other documentation as opportunities arise
- 2. BPA will remove references to the NERC ATC MODs from its ATC Methodology webpage
- 3. BPA will retire the TTC Study Report Request Form posted to the ATC Methodology website, as this form is associated with MOD-029, R4 and this requirement did not transition into NAESB's WEQ-023

## ATC Methodology Website Changes (cont.)

- BPA will retain the Data Request Form posted to the ATC Methodology website
  - a. BPA is working to revise this form to remove references to MOD-001,
     R9 and simplify it overall
  - b. Process to request data from BPA remains the same requestors should fill out the Data Request Form and email the completed form to nercatcstandards@bpa.gov
