Thank you for your letter of October 27, 2004, requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act. In your letter you request information on extra benefits (not commonly offered to all employees), such as superior academic achievement GS-7 entry level qualification, retainers, bonuses, tuition reimbursement, and student loan reimbursement, that have been offered to employees at BPA in the years 2000-2004. Specifically, you are requesting employee name, grade and step or hourly salary, manager's name at time benefit was received, department, routing, date benefit was activated or approved, type of benefit, annual benefit amount, total benefit amount, whether or not the benefit is still being offered or date benefit ended and if revoked, date and reason revoked.

Your request was received by our office on November 3, 2004 and has been logged in as FOIA #05-001.


