Thank you for your letter of February 7, 2005, requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act. In your letter you requested the following:


1. Copies of any and all Advanced Funding Agreements that the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) has executed;
2. Copies of any and all Advanced Payment Agreements that the BPA has executed;
3. Copies of the currently in -place Service Agreements that involve the Pacific or Southern Intertie (both AC and DC lines) for the purpose of determining the composition (in terms of megawatts of capacity) of the various contracted services that have rights to Intertie capacity, e.g., Ownership rights of BPA, PacifiCorp, Portland General Electric, 3<sup>rd</sup> AC Participant shares, Open Access Transmission Tariff (OATT) Point-to-Point arrangements, OATT Network arrangements, Formula Power Transmission arrangements, Integration of Resources arrangements, and any other services (please specify the type of arrangement included in this "other" category).
4. Copies of any summaries of the composition of the services (as sought in item #3) using the Pacific Intertie segment, both the AC and DC interties.
