

Dear Mr. Kindley:

Thank you for your letter of February 16, 2005, requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act. Specifically you asked for copies of all confirmation agreements for power purchases by Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) that BPA entered into during the period from April 1, 2001 through July 15, 2001 for delivery of power to BPA after November 1, 2001.

We received your request on February 22, 2005 and designated it FOIA 05-029. Mr. Gary Insley, Supervisory Public Utilities Specialist has been named as authorizing official for your request.

In your letter, you indicated your willingness to pay fees associated with processing up to \$100. Upon review of your request by the authorizing official, it appears the cost to process your request will exceed the \$100 fee limitation noted in your letter. Bonneville charges fees to process FOIA requests. These fees are calculated based on the hourly rate of the searching and reviewing employee(s) plus sixteen percent.

Mr. Insley has estimated fees associated with processing your request at approximately \$250. In order for us to consider your request perfected and begin the 20 working day response time allowed by FOIA, we require your signed agreement to pay the fee amount estimated above. Please provide your signature on the third page of this letter indicating your agreement to pay the estimated fees and return it to us. Upon receipt, our staff will promptly begin processing your request in the 20 working day time frame provided under the FOIA.
