As a follow-up to our letter dated April 27, 2005 regarding your FOIA request designated as FOIA #05-037, I am writing to provide a fee estimate for the processing of your request.

In your request letter you indicated a willingness to pay fees of up to \$100 and that if fee estimates exceed this amount, you would like an estimate before proceeding. Upon review of your request, we have estimated fees associated with processing your request will run approximately \$150. In order for us to consider your request perfected and begin the 20 working day response time allowed by FOIA, we require your signed agreement to pay the fee amount estimated. Please provide your signature on the second page of this letter indicating your agreement to pay the estimated fees and return it to us by fax (503-230-4576) or mail. Upon receiving your written agreement to estimated fees, we will re-establish a due date for your request and begin the 20 working day period of time allowed under the FOIA for processing.

Dear Mr. Stanton:

Thank you for your letter of April 20, 2005 requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA). In your request, you asked for

1. Copies of all internal and external documents, memo, correspondence, reports, etc., received and created relating to the old and proposed Bernhardt Heights Road from 1980 to the present. In particular, anything during that period pertaining to the access road that is a new road.
2. Copies of all procedures and policies pertaining to the establishment of public roads through power company lands and facilities, e.g., documents showing if public roads are allowed/encouraged and the specific criteria and full permitting process with contact information.

Your request was received by our office on April 27, 2005 and has been logged in as FOIA #05-037.

You have agreed to pay fees up to \$100 to process your request. You've asked that if fees for search, review and copy appear as though they may exceed \$100, we provide an estimate to you. As an individual requestor, FOIA allows for two hours of search time at no cost and up to 100 copied pages at no cost. There is no charge for review of responsive documents. Should search and copy charges exceed the two hour/100 page limits, processing fees are charged at the hourly rate of the searching employee plus 16 percent and \$.05 per copied page.
