From BPA: *Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request must contain following elements:*

**1. A statement that this is a request under the Freedom of Information Act.**

This request is made under the Freedom of Information Act for documents.

**2. A reasonable description of the documents sought.**

The Wedson Substation located near Florence Oregon 97439 is accessed via a county maintained road named Bernhardt Height Road. The documents sought pertain to this road and a proposal by Lane County to build a new road through the Wedson Substation using its current access driveway passing within 200 feet of its structures.

**A. Request** all internal and external documents, memo, correspondence, reports, etc. received and created relating to the present and also the proposed new Bernhardt Heights Road from 1 Jan 2002 to the present. Anything in that period pertaining to the Substation's driveway is part of this since it will be used as 1/2 the new Bernhardt Heights Road then go across more BPA lands. Lane County Public Works Department is already working on the Wedson Substation property, has notified road builders it wants to start building in July 2005, and wants a 70 foot Right-of-Way from everyone.

In the past, BPA's policy was to not allow the creation of new public roads passing within a few hundred feet of its sensitive substation facilities. No doubt to prevent vandalism and today to reduce terrorism threats. Wedson's driveway has a locked gate and is not visible from any public roads The existing road is traversed by private and commercial vehicles 26,000/year and the new one will add logging traffic.

**B. Request** all policies and procedures pertaining to the establishment of public roads onto sensitive BPA properties. Please also include the names, office telephone numbers, emails, and physical office locations of all those involved in the decision and any appeals through which Lane County must pass to gain permission to build its road.

**3. Requester's status is needed to determine appropriate assessment of fees.**

I am an individual seeking information for personal and not commercial use. I am living in one of the seven permanent residences using the existing dead-end road to be replaced by the new proposed million dollar dead-end road. I am also an immediate and second neighbor of the Substation.

**4. Requester must state a willingness to pay for costs resulting from processing a request. BPA charges no fee when the processing cost is less than \$15.**

I am willing to pay fees for this request up to a maximum of \$150. If you estimate the fees will exceed this number, please inform me first, so that I can reconsider.
