This letter is in response to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated May 17, 2005 and designated as FOIA #05-043. In your letter you requested:

1. Copies of all internal and external documents, memo, correspondence, reports, etc., received and created relating to the old and proposed Bernhardt Heights Road from Jan. 1, 2002 to the present. In particular, anything during that period pertaining to the Wedson Substation driveway.
2. Copies of all policies and procedures pertaining to the establishment of public roads onto sensitive BPA properties, to include the names, office telephone numbers, e-mails and physical office locations of all those involved in the decision and any appeals through which Lane County must pass to gain permission to build roads.

Per your telephone conversation with my associate, Ms. Debra Smiley, responsive documents for items one and two listed above have been provided, in their entirety, in CD format to Mr. Keith Stanton. The CD sent to Mr. Stanton contains documents responsive to your request as well as responsive documents for FOIA #05-042 originated by Mr. Stanton.

You had agreed to pay fees up to \$150 to process your request. As an individual requestor, FOIA allows for two hours of search time at no cost and up to 100 copies pages at no cost. Because this information required less than two hours of search time and is provided in CD format, there is no charge for processing this request.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of your receipt of this letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy,
