This letter responds to your request for information under the Freedom of Information Act and logged as FOIA #06-009. In your letter, you requested the following:

4. Memoranda, affidavits, recommendations or any other documents (authored subsequent to a final decision by BPA on awarding PIT contract bids) used by BPA to substantiate or support its decision to use the ISO 111784/85 compliant PIT tags (transponders) operating on 134.2 KHz frequency.

Additionally, you requested all written correspondence, contracts, contact information and other documents reflecting communications or agreements between BPA and any organization that purchased PIT tags from BPA that BPA had acquired pursuant to the PIT Contracts.

BPA is hereby providing the document in response to the above request. No information has been redacted from the documents. In your letter, you expressed a willingness to pay processing fees up to \$250 for your request. You will be sent an invoice in the amount of \$200 under separate cover by our accounting document.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to Director of Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue S.W., Washington, D.C. 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
