Thank you for your letter dated April 27, 2006, requesting information under the Freedom of Information Act. In your letter, you requested copies of documents relating to:

- Documents identifying loads as “contracted for, or committed to,” as determined by the Administrator within the meaning of § 3(13)(A) of the Regional Act.
- Correspondence or documents between BPA and any utility requesting, determining, establishing, confirming, or denying the “contracted for, or committed to” status of any load served by such utility.
- Correspondence between BPA and any load requesting, determining, establishing, confirming, or denying the “contract for, or committed to” status for such load.
- BPA policy statements or decisions interpreting or applying § 3(13)(A) of the Regional Act and/or the “contracted for, or committed to” standard.

Your request was received by our office on May 1, 2006, and has been logged in as #06-023. You have stated that you are willing to pay search and copy expenses to complete your request, not to exceed \$200 and have asked to be contacted if expenses are likely to exceed that amount.
