This letter responds to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your letter was received in this office on August 21, 2006, and was assigned a controlled number of 06-028. In your letter you requested the following:

- General project description of the landslide repair project, including dates of initiation and completion of the project(s), evaluation and final assessment or BPA efforts to accomplish its objectives and goals regarding the slide area
- Name and contact information for the project manager/supervisor of the BPA repair effort;
- Description of specific tasks performed by BPA and the objective of those tasks relative to repairing/buttressing/stabilizing the slide area

BPA has enclosed, in their entirety, all documents responsive to your above FOIA request in the form of emails, reports, charts, maps, drawings, photographs and other documents which have been provided in CD format.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to the Director of Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, DC 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
