This letter responds to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your letter was received in this office on Friday, March 2, 2007, and was assigned a control number, 07-019.

In your request you are asking for complete copies of all currently-effective BPA long-term transmission contracts which are designated as formula power transmission (FPT), integration of resource (IR), pre-order-888, "legacy", or "grandfathered" contracts and which are:

- referenced within and subject to the application of Section 4.2.2 of Transmission Services Available Transfer Capability (ATC) Methodology Business Practice (version 3, posted February 15, 2007); and/or
- are otherwise subject to the modeling process being undertaken as part of Transmission Services' current Commercial Business Process Improvement (CBPI) project.

After reviewing your letter, it was determined that you addressed all the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. In your request, you expressed a willingness to pay fees up to \$1,000 and have asked for us to contact you if the estimated fees exceed that amount. You have also asked that we send any responsive documents to you either in hard copy or on a CD to your address listed above.
