This letter is a partial response to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

In your request, and after our phone conversations with you, the scope was narrowed in that you were asking for a copy of the pre-award evaluation criteria and copies of any Contracts, Amendments, Releases and Deliverables between BPA and KEMA. The Exemption 4 process has been completed and BPA has provided copies of all contracts, amendments and releases with some segregable information released and other information withheld under Exemption 4 of the FOIA. Also provided, in its entirety, is a copy of the pre-award evaluation criteria. The deliverables external web-site link was previously released to you in a letter dated and sent to you on July 26, 2007.

The information redacted under Exemption 4 is "commercial" or "financial" information because it release to business activities. Exemption 4 protects "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential." Information that is required to be submitted by a person is "confidential" for purposes of Exemption 4 if disclosure is likely to either (1) impair the Government's ability to obtain reliable and high quality necessary information in the future; or (2) cause substantial harm to the competitive position of the person for whom the information is obtained.

If you are dissatisfied with our determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, DC 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
