This letter responds to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.A. § 552. Your letter was received in this office on Monday, July 2, 2007, and was assigned a control number, 07-032.

In your request you are asking for a copy of BPA's Contract PO #32660 for the Power Transformer, Hat Rock Substation, issued to Hyundai Heavy Industries in April 2007. You also stated that if the entire contract could not be provided, you would request the completed Compliance Summary and Technical Data sections, which began on Page 8 of Attachment 3 of the RFO for the project.
