Dear Mr. Johnson:

This letter is your final response to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552.

In your request, you asked for a copy of BPA's Contract PO #32660 for the Power Transformer, Hat Rock Substation, issued to Hyundai Heavy Industries in April 2007. You also stated that if the entire contract could not be provided, you would request the completed Compliance Summary and Technical Data sections, which began on Page 8 of Attachment 3 of the RFO for the project.

The Exemption 4 process has been completed and BPA has provided a copy of BPA Contract PO #32660 with some segregable information released and other information withheld under Exemption 4 of the FOIA. The information redacted under Exemption 4 is "commercial" or "financial" information because it related to business activities.

Exemption 4 protects "trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential." Information that is required to be submitted by a person is "confidential" for purposes of Exemption 4 if disclosure is likely to either (1) impair the Government's ability to obtain reliable and high quality necessary information in the future; or (2) cause substantial harm to the competitive position of the person for whom the information is obtained.

If you are dissatisfied with our determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, DC 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." You will be billed under separate cover by our Finance Department in the amount of \$173.60.
