This is your final response to your request for information that you submitted to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Initially, your letter was received in this office on Wednesday, September 5, 2007, and was assigned a control number, 07-043.

After our discussion, on Thursday, September 27, 2007, it was determined that you had met all the requirements of a proper FOIA request as stated at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 1004.4. You had agreed to pay processing fees in the amount of \$10.00 and had asked us to call you if the charges appeared to be higher. In our conversation, you also narrowed the scope of your initial request to what is listed below.

You were asking for a copy of the following:

1. BPA's report of their most recent visit to the Washington Department of Fish & Wildlife Pilot Grazing Project on the Blue Mountain WMA?

BPA conducted a reasonable search of their files and found no responsive documents.

If you are dissatisfied with our determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, DC 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal." There will be no charges for your request.
