This letter responds to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your request was received in this office on Friday, January 11, 2008, and has been assigned a control number, 08-017.

**You have requested the following information on all individuals in Generation Asset Management (PG). Any award (\$ amount) given to an individual. This is not limited to the following but should include the following:**

1. One time payment of retention bonus
2. Ongoing retention allowance pay
3. Quality Step Increases
4. Special Act
5. Sustained Superior Performance
6. Accretion of duties that led to a promotion
7. One time bonus awards
8. Hiring bonus
9. Awards that were given and later retracted
10. Tuition reimbursement
11. Student loan reimbursement (2004-2007 and broken out as to name of recipient and the age of recipient when they received the award)
12. Student loan reimbursement (2004-2007, etc. for individuals in Scheduling Coordination group (PTK), both when they were in Generation Asset Management (PGK), and in Bulk Marketing (PTK).

After reviewing your request, it was determined that you addressed all the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, Department of Energy, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004.
