Thank you for your request for information you made under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552 to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA). Your letter was received in this office on Wednesday, March 12, 2008, and has been assigned a control number, 08-032. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

**You have asked for the following:**

Documents relating to BPA's contract(s) with Washington2 Advocates since January 1, 2007. For purposes of this FOIA, the term "BPA" includes all employees, contractors and agents. The term "Washington2 Advocates" includes all employees, contractors and agents.

1. Copies of all contracts and/or contract amendments between BPA and Washington2 Advocates;
2. Copies of all invoices submitted by Washington2 Advocates to BPA;
3. Copies of all communications, whether in written or electronic form, between BPA and Washington2 Advocates. For purposes of this request, "communications" includes all correspondence, emails and their attachments (whether generated by BPA, W2A or others);
4. Copies of all work product and written advice, including by not limited to statements of work, reports, analyses, newsletters and other documents, whether in written or electronic form, submitted by Washington2 Advocates to BPA; and
5. The names, dates and titles of all individuals contacted by Washington2 Advocates on behalf of BPA.

After reviewing your letter, it was determined that you addressed all the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004, and have agreed to pay up to \$150.00 in fees associated with the request.
