Dear Mr. Seligman:

This is your final response to your request for information you made under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552 to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA).

You requested the following:

Documents relating to BPA's contract(s) with Washington2 Advocates since January 1, 2007. For purposes of this FOIA, the term "BPA" includes all employees, contractors and agents. The term "Washington2 Advocates" includes all employees, contractors and agents.

1. Copies of all contracts and/or contract amendments between BPA and Washington2 Advocates;

Response: Pages 1 thru 6 released in their entirety.

2. Copies of all invoices submitted by Washington2 Advocates to BPA;

Response: Pages 7 thru 22 with some information redacted under Exemption 6 of the FOIA.

3. Copies of all communications, whether in written or electronic form, between BPA and Washington2 Advocates. For purposes of this request, "communications" includes all correspondence, emails and their attachments (whether generated by BPA, W2A or others);

Response: Pages 23 thru 80 and 85 thru 195 are released in their entirety. Pages 81 thru 84 are released with some information redacted under Exemption 6 of the FOIA.

4. Copies of all work product and written advice, including by not limited to statements of work, reports, analyses, newsletters and other documents, whether in written or electronic form, submitted by Washington2 Advocates to BPA; and

Response: Pages 196 thru 208 released in their entirety.

5. The names, dates and titles of all individuals contacted by Washington2 Advocates on behalf of BPA.

Response: We have no responsive document to this request.

In Item 2, we are withholding taxpayer number, bank account and routing numbers from these records because they are protected under Exemption 6 of the FOIA. Exemption 6 of the FOIA protects personnel, medical and similar files when disclosure would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)).

In Item 3, we are withholding a resume and personal information of a non-Federal employee that is protected under Exemption 6 of the FOIA. Exemption 6 of the FOIA protects personnel, medical and similar files when disclosure would cause a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy (5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6)).

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independent Avenue SW, Washington, DC 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
