Thank you for your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552. Your letter was received in this office on Friday, May 9, 2008, and was assigned a controlled number, 08-046. You requested a copy of the licensing agreement between the DOE and Seattle City Light with regard to the Dams on the Skagit River.

After reviewing your FOIA request, it was determined that your request was transferred to us in error and any records that may exist are under the jurisdiction of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). For this reason, I have transferred your request to the FOIA Officer at that location for proper action.
