Thank you for the request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. 2. Documents relating to any interviews, statements, reviews, inspections or any documents generated as a result of any investigations that may have been conducted by BPA in relation to the accident that occurred on the "Mount Vernon" section of the project on July 26, 2006.
