Our law firm is representing individuals injured in a pipeline construction incident that occurred on July 27, 2006. On that day workers for Welded Construction were preparing to install a 1300 ft length of 36 inch diameter natural gas pipe when the boom on a D8 Cat came in close proximity to a 230 KV power line operated by BPA. Six employees working on the line sustained injuries from electrical shock and were hospitalized. The location was one quarter mile up a service road off of 156<sup>th</sup> Street NE, near Arlington Washington.


I am requesting by this letter records under the Freedom of Information Act. Our firm is willing to pay for the costs related to providing documents as requested.

Specifically, I am requesting any and all material in your files pertaining to any and all investigations of this incident, including, but not limited to, land use agreements, incident witness statements, incident reports, drawings and or scene sketches, power line height measurements, equipment height measurements, land surveys, distance measurement, photographs, video tapes, OSHA correspondence, correspondence to and from Northwest Pipeline Company; Williams Company; Welded Construction Company; Quality Inspection Services; and any other entity involved in or with the incident.
