This is in response to the enclosed request for information that you submitted to DOE Headquarters under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. § 552 and they transferred to our office on August 26, 2008, for action.

You have requested descriptions of all mailing lists requested, through FOIA, from the DOE Headquarters, Field Offices and Laboratories since January 1, 2003. Specifically, you were interested in:

1. Date request was made;
2. Type of mailing list requested;
3. Requester's name;
4. Name of company the requester is affiliated with, if any;
5. The purpose the mailing list was requested for;
6. Whether the agency provided the mailing list and if any information was redacted and under what exemption of the FOIA;
7. Kinds of data provided;
8. Total number of individuals whose data was provided; and
9. Total FOIA processing fees charged to the requester.

A search was conducted of the files of Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) for documents responsive to the request. BPA has no responsive documents to your request and there will be no charge.

If you are dissatisfied with this determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, D.C. 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
