This is the final response to the enclosed Office of Inspector General (OIG) response to the above referenced Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request dated September 15, 2008.

In that request you asked for copies of all IG referral documents, memoranda and/or letters, and DOE program management responses that pertain to DOE IG Hotline case number I08RS035. The OIG identified the enclosed Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) document, labeled Document 2, as responsive to your request and forwarded it to our Agency for release determination. In addition, the OIG has withheld material from Document 2 pursuant to Exemptions 6 and 7(C), as stated in their response letter to you dated August 6, 2008. After reviewing the document, BPA releases that record to you with no additional information withheld under the FOIA.

If you are dissatisfied with our determination, you may make an appeal within thirty (30) days of receipt of the letter to Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue SW, Washington, DC 20585. Both the envelope and the letter must be clearly marked "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."
