This letter is an update to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. I have amended your initial request to reflect those changes you provided in your email dated Monday, January 5, 2009, to more narrowly define and clarify the scope of your request.

You requested the following:

1. Copies of LGIAs for projects that are already completed: Big Horn, Klondike I, II, III and IIIa, White Creek, Leaning Juniper and Stateline (Washington side) and;
2. Copies of LGIAs (to the extent that they are within the 2220 MWs contemplated) for Pebble Springs, Hay Canyon, Leaning Juniper II North and II South, Juniper Canyon 1 and 2, and Star Point, all being developed by Iberdrola; and Windy Point, which is being developed by Turlock Irrigation District.
