This letter is a partial response to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You have requested the following:

1. A copy of the original contract between BPA and Alcoa (contract no. 06PB-11744) and between BPA and CFAC (contract no. 06PB-11745).

Response: BPA has provided copies of all responsive documents in their entirety.

2. The rates for power used to calculate the monetization benefits between contract signing and January 1, 2009.

Response: Equivalent PF from October 2006 through September 2008 = \$25.87/MWh
Equivalent PF from October 2008 through November 2008 = \$25.44/MWh

3. A summary showing the monthly payments paid by BPA to Alcoa and CFAC since the contracts were signed to the present, including payments made under any amendments to the contracts.

Response: BPA has provided the responsive summary in its entirety.

4. All correspondence between BPA and Alcoa and between BPA and CFAC regarding the contracts and any amendments to the contracts and their implementation since contract signing and the date of this FOIA request (February 20, 2009).
