Referring to the May 2007 Northwest Power Pool BPA Power Point presentation title "I-5 Corridor Reinforcement Project Plan of Service Status Report" dated May 15, 2007. \*Please provide all the underlying environmental, technical and financial data/reports that selected Option #3. In addition, any report now that Option #3 is no longer being routed as originally shown (way East of current segment 29 and now going through inhabited section of Clark County).
