Description of Request: In May 2007 at the Northwest Power Pool (NWPP) BPA made a PowerPoint presentation Titled I-5 Corridor Reinforcement Project Plan of Service Status Report May15, 2007. Three options were shown 1. Upgrading lower voltage systems. 2. two options through Oregon (Paul-Pearl and Lexington-Ross) and 3. Paul-Troutdale. NOTE: option 3 shows routing going further east than any currently proposed options that are being scoped. Please provide all the underlying environmental, technical and financial data (in other words the report/s) that selected options 3. In addition any updates to the report/s now that option 3 is no longer being routing as originally shown (way East of current segment 29 and now going through inhabited section of Clark County).
