This is a final response to your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

**You requested the following, which includes an emailed addendum dated March 19, 2010:**

1. Copies of all communications between BPA and BEF (including its lawyers) regarding the contract prior to Administrator Wright signing the agreement on January 30, 2009. "Communications" are to include all communications including emails, between BPA executives (e.g., Administrator Wright, Steve Hickok, Paul Norman) and individual BEF board members (e.g., board chairman Walt Pollock) if the topic of the communication was related in any way to the draft BPA-BEF contract.

**Response:**
