Thank you for your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your letter was received in this office on Monday, May 24, 2010, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2010-01462-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about you request.

You have requested the following:

All initial and revised documents related to segment 52: LIDAR printouts with proposed overlays, including the complete Hardshell, with both top and side views of all options being considered. Rebuilding of lines, FAA restrictions, distances from existing buildings (homes, offices etc.), properties which will be required to grant additional easements, properties that will be condemned, impact to Camas/Washougal city wells and equipment and the environmental impacts this project will have on the Washougal River.
