#### **You have requested the following:**

1. All landowner maps (large and small scale) including the Google Earth overlays for all segments in Oregon plus segments 46A, 47, 48 and 49, which are in Washington and are all identified on BPA map nzehntbauer08-18segsm dated Sept 14, 2009. The requested maps to be similar to the ones provided to the WA segments. Request both hard and softcopy of all landowner maps.
2. All initial and revised documents related to segments of 46A through 91 (identified on BPA map nzehntbauer08-18segsm dated Sept 14, 2009): LIDAR printouts with proposed overlays, including complete Hardshell, with both top and side views.
