I request a waiver or reduction of fees because my request concerns "the operations or activities of the government" as explained below:

It is necessary to understand the communication that BPA has had with Clark and Cowlitz Counties, as well as the Cities of Vancouver, Camas, Washougal and Longview prior to (July, 2009) to current date.

I request a waiver or reduction of fees because the disclosure is "likely to contribute" to an understanding of government operations or activities as explained below:
