Thank you for your request for information that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U. S.C. 552. Your letter was received in this office on Monday, August 30, 2010, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2010-01994. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

We have reviewed your letter and have determined that it addresses all the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA and the DOE regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. Your fee waiver request has been granted.
