This is a partial response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You have requested the following:

Any and all records related in any way to Mud Lake and/or Circle C Rock Products located at NW 334th Street and Pekin Ferry Road in Ridgefield, Clark County, Washington.

Response:

BPA is providing the enclosed responsive documents either in their entirety or some information withheld under Exemption 6. BPA asserts this exemption for information which could reasonably be expected to constitute an unwarranted invasion of personal privacy if disclosed. The withheld information consists of personal cell phone numbers of individuals working on this project. Release of this information could subject these individuals to unwanted intrusions of privacy. There is no public interest in the disclosure of this information because it does not shed any light on how BPA has performed its statutory duties.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC 20585-1615. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA Appeal is being made.

This is a final response to your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552.

You have requested the following:

Any and all records related in any way to Mud Lake and/or Circle C Rock Products located at NW 334th Street and Pekin Ferry Road in Ridgefield, Clark County, Washington.

Response:

BPA provided responsive documents to you on August 18, 2011, with the exception of an appraisal of a 340.00 acre tract of vacant rural land that was submitted to us by the Department of Environmental Services, Clark County Washington. In accordance with Executive Order 12,600 and Department of Energy Regulation 10 CFR 1004.11, BPA sent a letter giving them an opportunity to present their view on disclosure of the requested information. They requested that BPA not release the appraisal, claiming Exemption 4 and 5 under FOIA.

Attached is a letter that is being sent to Clark County that describes the reasons why BPA is withholding the appraisal under Exemption 4. No fees will be charged for this request.

Pursuant to 10 CFR 1004.8, if you are dissatisfied with this determination, or the adequacy of the search, you may appeal in writing within 30 calendar days of receipt of a final response letter. The appeal should be made to the Director, Office of Hearings and Appeals, HG-1, Department of Energy, 1000 Independence Avenue, SW, Washington, DC 20585-1615. The written appeal, including the envelope, must clearly indicate that a FOIA Appeal is being made.
