Thank you for your request for records that you made to the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA), under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), 5 U.S.C. 552. Your letter was received in this office today, and has been assigned a control number, BPA-2011-01635-F. Please use this number in any correspondence with the Agency about your request.

#### **You have requested the following:**

Copies of documentation that identifies the number of impacted homeowner and landowners within the notification and buffer zone for all route segments currently still being considered for the I-5 project. This is to include whether the parcel is private, corporate or public lands and where there is a residence, the distance each residence is from the center line (or an alternate identified point) of the proposed line.

We have reviewed your letter and have determined that it addresses all of the criteria of a proper request under the FOIA, DOE, and BPA regulation that implements the FOIA at Title 10, Code of Federal Regulations, Part 1004. Your fee waiver has been granted.
