PTR Accepting Measures Not Reported to BPA -

The Planning, Tracking, and Reporting system will now accept measures and projects that are not BPA-reportable. This feature will help utilities assemble comprehensive reports for purposes other than BPA reporting. For example, by using the PTR to report all projects, including projects that will not be reported to BPA, a utility can generate a comprehensive report of all energy efficiency achievements for internal reviews and/or non-BPA reporting requirements.

The PTR will make an "internal report" function available by June 1, 2011, allowing utilities to generate a full report, inclusive of these not BPA-reportable entries.
