As of March 31, 2012 utilities will no longer be required to submit DHP forms to the DHP site registry. BPA Program staff will continue to be available to provide support to utilities to assist them with installation and documentation requirements.

This brown bag will cover: where to find forms, qualified products, and program support, how the site registry, QC and QA will work, what assistance NEEA will continue to provide via NWductless.com, and provide an opportunity for utilities to ask any questions they might have about the ongoing DHP transition...
