## **High Performance Manufactured Home presentation posted -**

For the past year, BPA and Northwest Energy Works (NEW) have been working to develop a higher efficiency specification for new manufactured homes, as well as an updated NEEM reporting system. On May 15th the RTF approved the UES for this High Performance Manufactured Home (HPMH) specification, estimated to deliver 50% greater savings over the current NW Energy Efficient Manufactured Home (NEEM) spec.

On June 18th, BPA and NEW hosted a presentation of the High Performance Manufactured Home specification. The presentation included the history of BPA and utility involvement with the Manufactured Housing industry, an overview of the current state of the industry and the NEEM program, a detailed presentation of the High Performance Manufactured Home (HPMH) specification, a discussion of program mechanisms for consideration, and possible next steps.
