Borrow the Save a Watt (SAW) costume and other materials for events, meetings, and parades in your utility service territory* . *Children especially love SAW.*

Instructions and recommendations:

1. The SAW costume consists of: One Watt head, white jump suit, and white turtleneck shirt. The costume will fit a small to average size individual (you provide the individual).
2. Volunteers wearing the costume need to wear white tennis shoes.
3. SAW volunteers *should not* talk while wearing the costume. The character should behave like a mime.
4. SAW volunteers can wave to people, give individuals the thumbs up or thumbs down signal, dance, and shake hands. "Suitable" silliness is acceptable.
5. No lewd conduct, gestures, smoking or drinking any alcoholic beverages while in costume.
