Eugene Control House gets facelift

What: The Eugene Control House that was built in the 1930s is in the process of a much needed facelift. The building has been stripped of asbestos and lead paint. A thermoelastic coating (instead of paint) has been put on the building that will not need maintenance for years, new windows, central heating and air conditioning, brass lettering and glass blocks in the doorway similar to the blocks installed when the building was built.

Who: Crews are working feverishly around state-of-the-art equipment which continues to operate as the construction is being done. Come with your cameras!
