KENT, Wash. – In the late hours of Oct. 11, 2000, a BPA helicopter was vandalized at the Covington Substation near Kent, Wash. BPA is offering a reward of up to \$1,000 for any information leading to the arrest and conviction of those responsible.

The vandals threw rocks at the helicopter, severely damaging the right and left door windows. The King County Sheriff is investigating the incident. BPA estimates the damage at about \$5,000.
