

BPA has counted the number of land parcels that would require negotiation of easement rights for a new transmission line. Many segments would require all new rights-of-way to be purchased. There are a few areas along BPA's existing transmission line easement rights or rights-of-way where BPA would need to acquire additional rights to accommodate a new line.

Each parcel was assigned to a segment. At intersections of multiple segments, parcels were only assigned to one segment to eliminate duplicate counting. Some landowners own multiple parcels, so we also counted the number of landowners with whom BPA would negotiate purchase of new or additional rights for each segment.
