To: Bonneville's Directly Connected and Transfer Customers

This letter supplements Bonneville Power Administration's (Bonneville) May 25, 2007, Letters of Commitment to Directly-Connected and Transfer Customers. In those letters, Bonneville committed to: (i) continue to perform those activities on or with respect to each utility's system that it currently performs and that are now subject to the mandatory electric reliability standards and, (ii) be responsible for penalties and sanctions imposed for violations of the standards applicable to those activities.

This commitment was to terminate on the earlier of the effective date of the Agreement for Performance of Certain Activities Required under Electric Reliability Standards Contracts (Delegation Agreement) that Bonneville planned to offer or October 1, 2007. However, due to a delay in Bonneville's offer of those Delegation Agreements, Bonneville is extending this commitment. The May 25, 2007, commitment to each utility shall terminate on the earlier of: (i) the effective date of the Delegation Agreement that has been offered to such utility or, (ii) November 15, 2007.
