

TSLG Seminar Announcement -- October 14, 2004

Greetings,

At the last RRG Meeting, September 23-24, 2004, TSLG announced that it will hold a seminar on October 14, 2004. At this seminar, TSLG members and consultants will provide an overview of the work completed to date on the market and operational design for Grid West's Beginning State.

TSLG's work this summer focused on providing a first order of detail for the Beginning State that shows the feasibility of implementing the features described in the Regional Proposal. The Seminar will cover transmission rights administration, transmission reconfiguration services, scheduling processes and responsibilities, and reserve and real-time energy markets that can be used by Grid West to meet the Ancillary Service requirements of a consolidated control area.

The Seminar will be held **October 14, 2004** from **8:30 am to 3:30 pm** at a hotel in the vicinity of the **Portland** Airport. Details on the hotel will be provided in a subsequent notice once booking arrangements have been completed. The Seminar is scheduled to follow the RRG Meeting of October 12-13, 2004 to minimize travel for those coming from outside the Portland area.

The Seminar will be open to participation by RRG participants or by others interested in TSLG's work. Advance written material for the Seminar will be posted on the website during the week preceding the Seminar. In addition to providing time for questions and answers during the Seminar, written questions will accepted after the seminar and a conference call will be scheduled on October 25 to provide responses to follow-up questions.
