**PETITION TO INTERVENE OF THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION
OF OREGON**

The Public Utility Commission of Oregon (OPUC) requests to intervene in the BPA's ASC Filings Expedited Process for the utilities listed below. The OPUC has intervened in the ongoing 2007 Supplemental Wholesale Power Rate Adjustment Proceeding and wishes to intervene in these cases in order to ensure Residential Exchange Benefits are appropriately apportioned among participating northwest utilities. Accordingly, the OPUC asks to intervene in the proceedings concerning the utilities that it regulates, as well as the proceedings concerning all other participating utilities:

Also since any utility's ASC affects residential exchange benefits, and there is an overall cap in total residential exchange benefits, each utility's ASC could affect the benefit level for the other utilities. As the regulator of investor-owned utility rates in

Oregon, we have an interest in the ASCs of all utilities filing for residential exchange benefits.
