

**COLUMBIA RIVER TREATY ENTITY AGREEMENT ON THE  
2010 SUMMER STORAGE AGREEMENT (10NTSSA)**

The Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) and the British Columbia Hydro and Power Authority (B.C. Hydro) have signed an agreement relating to the use of Columbia River non-Treaty storage for the period 5 June 2010 through 10 September 2010 (BPA Contract number 10PB-20362). The United States and Canadian Entities have reviewed this Agreement and are satisfied that there are mutual benefits to be derived from it and that these benefits can be achieved without adversely affecting: (1) the operation of Treaty space in accordance with the Columbia River Treaty; or (2) the performance of Treaty obligations pursuant to the agreement entitled "Aspects of Delivery of the Canadian Entitlement." The Columbia River Treaty Operating Committee is hereby instructed to ensure that any operation pursuant to this Agreement does not adversely affect operation of Treaty space pursuant to the Columbia River Treaty.

In witness thereof, the Entities have caused this agreement to be executed.
