To whom it may concern:

We are the owners of lots 61 and 62 in Bighorn Terrace and we have some questions with the Libby (fec) to Troy rebuild. We are wondering why the line is being rerouted away from most of the lots in Bighorn Terrace, but not all the lots. This would add beauty and value to those lots getting the line removed. It seems your plan falls short by several feet of removing the line from all the lots in Bighorn Terrace. We have plans to build a home close to the existing easement and your plan to upgrade the line and increase your easement will then run into our dream home. Our lots also contain a creek and wet lands, home to many plants and animals. Our lot is a triangular lot with the existing easement shrinking our property. With the additional easement you need our lot will decrease in size and value. This is our dream house, please help. Since the poles are being replaced, we would like to see the line moved up the hill, which includes two poles, a short distance compared to the length of the proposed moved. Move the lines off our land and we will support the upgrade and we will give you access through our land to perform your work. Leave the lines and we will not give you any access or easement and will fight the change, including local and national official and any agency willing to help. We met with Renee Dickson on Sept. 14 and Robert Ochs on Sept. 15 to discuss our concerns. Please respond in a timely manner if you have heard us and are considering our proposed change.
